



SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011

PRESCHOOL is for 2, 3, and 4 year-olds and is offered for full or part-time participation. This is a loving but structured environment within which a child develops learning skills. Preschool is offered on a school year basis or as a year-around program. (A separate fee schedule is attached.)

KINDERGARTEN (FULL DAY) is a valuable program in the overall training of the child for daily living. It is also a period of preparation and readiness for school participation. The activity experiences are designed to help the child adjust socially, coordinate physically, grow spiritually, and prepare mentally for the first grade. The A Beka curriculum is used. Our program is taught by certified teachers. Classroom period is 8:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with the beginning bell at 8:10 a.m.

ELEMENTARY- HIGH SCHOOL (1-12) meets or exceeds the basic curriculum outlined by the Florida Department of Education, teaching the subjects necessary for the child's training, integrating the Bible throughout. The aim of the curriculum is to develop the basic skills and lay a foundation for a Christian world and life view. All classes and subjects are taught by certified teachers. Classroom period is 8:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for grades 1-5, 8:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. for the secondary grades, with the beginning bell five minutes before the starting time.

TUITION SCHEDULE

Tuition may be paid by one of the following plans:

- (1) **By the year in advance** (2% discount will apply if paid prior to August 1, 2010)
- (2) **By the semester in advance**- July 1st and January 1st
- (3) **Twelve equal payments**- June 2010 through May 2011 (10% of the annual tuition is non-refundable if the student does not attend in the fall).
- (4) **In ten equal payments**- June 2010 through May 2011, except July & August (10% of the annual tuition is non-refundable if the student does not attend in the fall).

GENERAL INFORMATION

When a child enrolls in Keswick Christian School, a place is reserved for the entire school year. Parents are requested to make every effort to complete each semester before changes in schools or communities are made. When a change during the school year becomes unavoidable, tuition charges will be prorated. Report Cards and Transcripts are released to pupils, parents, or other schools only when the student's account is paid up to date.

PAST DUE ACCOUNTS

Tuition payments are due on the first of each month. A late fee of \$30.00 will be added to accounts after 10 days, plus a 1% carrying charge on the unpaid balance. If an account is not paid within 60 days, the parents may be asked to withdraw their child(ren) from school.

It also covers the costs of the secondary school spiritual emphasis week.
