



Supply List for 2009/2010

Kindergarten (K5 - bring supplies to Open House)

- Small rectangle eraser
- 1 box of 24 Crayola Crayons
- 2 large glue sticks
- Scissors
- 2 Crayola watercolor paint sets
- 1 box of 8 Crayola markers
- 6 plain, laminated or plastic folders w/pockets and **NO PRONGS** (2 green, 2 red, and 2 yellow)

- 1 - 1" white 3-ring binder w/clear plastic cover
 - 1 - 48x24 bath towel for rest time
 - 1 large box of Kleenex

First Grade

- Bible (KJV preferred)
- 2 laminated folders w/pockets at bottom (**no prongs**)
- 2 glue sticks - (labeled w/ name)
- Scissors - (labeled w/name)
- Supply box-not too large
- 1 pkg. #2 pencils (4 sharp-ened)
- 1 wide-ruled spiral notebook
- 1 lg. Box Kleenex

- 2 lg. Erasers (pink, rectangular)
 - 1 box 24 crayons (including 8 primary colors)
 - 1 box colored pencils
 - Backpack **without wheels**
 - Ruler (inches & centimeters - label w/name)
 - 1 pkg. 4 colors Expo dry erase markers (**NOT low odor - they are harmful to our whiteboards**)

Second Grade

- Bible - (KJV or NIV)
- #2 pencils & several erasers
- 1 box colored pencils (**NO markers!**)
- 2 Red and 1 Yellow heavy, plastic folders **w/pockets and NO prongs**
- Supply box (not too large)
- 1 pkg. 4 colors Expo markers (**NOT low odor - they are harmful to our whiteboards**)
- 2 - 8x10 spiral notebooks
- Ruler (inches & centimeters)

- 1 - 1", 3-ring binder w/clear plastic cover

 - 2 lg. pkgs. wide-ruled notebook paper

 - For Spanish:** 1 green folder w/bottom pockets & 1 Expo marker (**NOT low odor**)

Fourth Grade

- Bible (KJV)

- Supply box

- 2 - 4-packs Expo markers w/erasers (**NOT low odor - they are harmful to our whiteboards**)
- 1 box 16 or more crayons
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Colored pencils
- Ruler (inches & centimeters)

- 5 folders w/pockets
 - \$1.50 for 5 KCS book covers (purchase from teacher or Armory)
 - 1 - 1" 3-ring binder w/clear plastic cover

- 4 **DARK** colors Expo markers (**NOT low odor - they are harmful to our whiteboards**)

 - 2 spiral notebooks
 - 1 black & white composition notebook
 - 1 container Clorox wipes
 - 1 box Kleenex
 - 1 roll paper towels
 - 5 *pocket/prong* folders (1 red, 1 blue, 2 green, 1 yellow)
 - Paperback compact dictionary/thesaurus
 - 5th grade novels** (see 2nd page of supply list for titles)

For Physical Education (K5-3rd) - Shorts must be fingertip length for girls who take off jumpers for P.E. *Shoes must tie, have Velcro or have strong elastic. (No sandals, slip-on shoes, or crocs.)*

For Physical Education (4th & 5th grades) - Plain White T-shirt, white KCS P. E. t-shirt, or any Keswick T-shirt from camp, athletics, etc., and green mesh fingertip length shorts from Allen's Sporting Goods. The athletic bag and every item in it should be **labeled with student's name**. *Shoes must tie, have Velcro or have strong elastic. (No sandals, slip-on shoes, or crocs.)*

Shoes for REGULAR school day in all grades K-5: Students should wear low healed, properly laced, athletic shoes to school. **No sandals, boots, or crocs permitted.**

IMPORTANT NOTE: Because of new whiteboards, all Expo Markers should **NOT** be low odor.
