2010 Summer Reading Lists

6th Grade:

- 6th graders should read **400** pages of their own choosing (grade level books they have not previously read). Students should log their reading to include book title, author, dates and pages read then have a parent sign the log. The logs are due the first day when classes resume in August 2009.

7th Grade:

- 7th graders should read **500** pages of their own choosing (any grade level book they have not previously read). Students should log their reading to include book title, author, dates and pages read then have a parent sign the log. The logs are due the first day when classes resume in August 2009.

8th Grade:

- 8th grade should read **600** pages of their own choosing (any grade level book they have not previously read). Students should log their reading to include book title, author, dates and pages read then have a parent sign the log. The logs are due the first day when classes resume in August 2009.

All Junior High Students may apply their reading logs to the KCS Library summer reading program.
